If you do not have an educational qualification at degree level this will not necessarily prevent a successful application. However, all FIOM applicants are expected to provide information in Parts C and D that demonstrates responsibilities such as

- governance of the organisation, e.g., board of directors;
- executive ownership of technical or commercial outcomes at the organisational level;
- establishing and reviewing policies for safety, legislation, regulation, standards, process, systems, tools and workforce planning & development;
- scoping or leading standards activities, academic research or professional development.

In Part E give contact information for up to two supporters who are willing to support your application by confirming the information you gave in Parts C and D.

In Part F confirm your declarations by signing and dating the form.
