Booking Conditions / Cancellation Policy

Registrations can only be confirmed upon receipt of payment or proof of payment. International Institute of Obsolescence Management Ltd (IIOM International) regrets that no cancellations can be accepted; however, if a delegate is not able to attend a substitute delegate will be accepted.
