



## Terms and conditions for IIOM International Conference 2021

### **Booking Conditions / Cancellation Policy**

Registrations can only be confirmed upon receipt of payment or proof of payment.

International Institute of Obsolescence Management Ltd (IIOM International) regrets that no cancellations can be accepted; however, if a delegate is not able to attend a substitute delegate will be accepted.

It may be necessary for reasons beyond the control of IIOM International to alter the content, timing and venue. In the unlikely event the conference is cancelled for any such reason, IIOM International will make a refund of the registration fee, but do not accept responsibility for any travel, accommodation cost or consequential losses incurred. We therefore recommend that prospective delegates arrange appropriate insurance cover.

### **Registration Fee**
